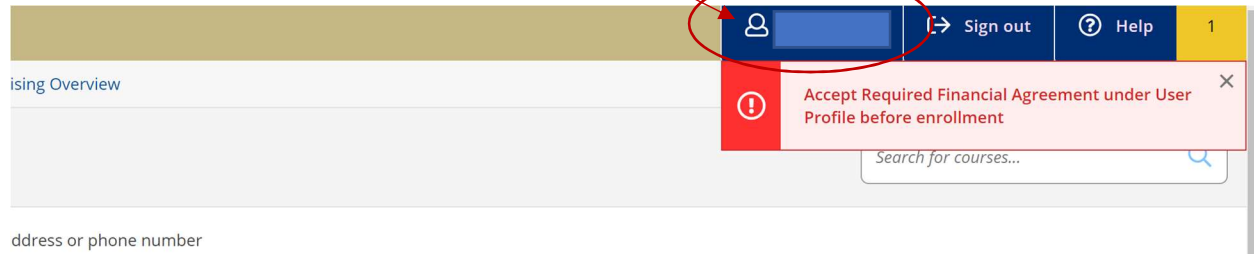


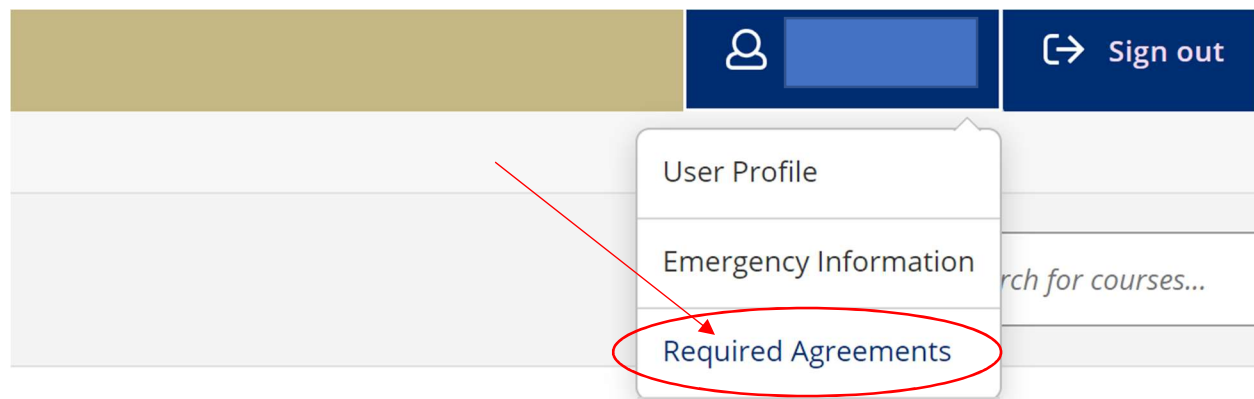
## STUDENT FINANCIAL AGREEMENT HOLDS

Before being cleared to enroll for the Summer 2021/Fall 2021 semesters, all returning students review and accept the updated TU Student Financial Agreement as provided in Self-Service.

1. To review and accept the agreement, students must log in to their Self-Service account at [selfservice.utulsa.edu](https://selfservice.utulsa.edu). Once logged in, click on the User Profile icon in the top right corner.



2. Choose Required Agreements from the menu drop down




3. Once arriving at the Required Agreements Page, select View on the line with the Student Financial Responsibility title.

This Enrollment and Financial Responsibility Agreement (Agreement) is entered into between you, the student, and The University of Tulsa (University). This is a legally binding document, and you should read it carefully.

**Student Responsibility:** By signing this Agreement, you agree to be fully responsible for the payment of all student account charges incurred arising from or relating to your enrollment and attendance at the University, including but not limited to: tuition, student fees, course fees, housing and dining charges, "gold" charges, and finance charges/collection fees on amounts not paid when due (collectively, "Educational Expenses").

Your enrollment, including payment or refund of any Educational Expenses, is governed by applicable University policies, which may be changed from time to time. Tuition and fee schedules and refund policies are published on the University's Schedule of Courses at [Course Schedule](#)

Tuition and fees are subject to change each semester or other period of enrollment. Unless the tuition schedule expressly indicates otherwise, tuition and fees are the same regardless of mode of delivery of university instruction (e.g., in-person, remote or
